

Fundraising and Event Coordinator

Position Summary

The Fundraising and Event Coordinator for the Vascular Birthmarks Foundation (VBF) will be responsible for organizing fundraising events, including scheduling the venues, contacting potential donors, developing advertising campaigns, overseeing volunteers, and managing the events. This position also involves creation of new fundraising initiatives and building relationships with donors, board members, volunteers and the community. This is a 20 hour/week, remote contractor position. Some in-person work required for onsite event management. Compensation is \$25 per hour.

Responsibilities:

- Organize and execute both small and large scale fundraising events, campaigns, and activities (both virtual and in-person)
- Recruit and manage event volunteers
- Onsite logistical coordination for fundraising events
- Cultivate and maintain relationships with donors
- Prepare event budgets
- Monitor payments and maintain financial reports
- Create and implement new fundraising initiatives
- Collaborate with marketing team to promote fundraising activities
- Partner with the Development Coordinator on donor relations, event revenue, and sponsorship
